Rowing WA and Rowing Australia would like to extend an invitation to all Masters Rowers to compete at the 2010 Australian Masters Rowing Championships. The championships will be held from Thursday 3rd to Sunday 6th of June 2010 at the newly constructed Champion Lakes Regatta Centre in Armadale.

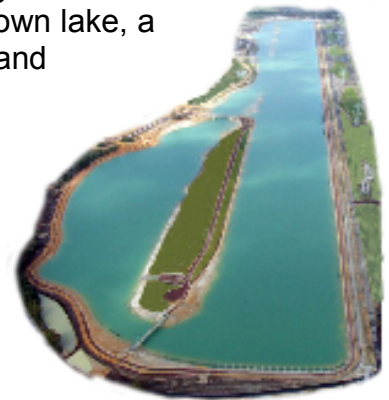
The Venue: Champion Lakes Regatta Centre

Nestled within the City of Armadale, Champion Lakes Regatta Centre (CLRC) is just 23kms from the heart of Perth's CBD. The CLRC is easily accessed via road, with a quick 30 minute drive from the city via the Kwinana Freeway or the Albany and Tonkin Highways. There is also access to Perth's rail network close by, with 3 train stations being with in 3kms of the course's facilities.

The \$34 million Champion Lakes Regatta Centre facility was completed in 2007 and is one of only two purpose built rowing courses in Australia. The design of the course



incorporates a 700m warm-up/cool-down lake, a fully buoyed 2000 metre course and brand new athlete and spectator facilities. There is also a purpose built events path that runs the length of the course, for use by coaches and the media during the event.



Raised grass embankments run the length of the western side of the course and provide an excellent view of the whole course for spectators.

HOW TO GET TO PERTH

All the major Australian airlines including Qantas, Virgin, Jetstar and Tiger fly direct to Perth from most capital cities.

MASTERS AGE CATEGORIES

The 2009 Australia Masters Rowing Championships are to be conducted in accordance with Rowing Australia rules of racing which can be viewed on the Rowing Australia website (http://www.rowingaustralia.com.au/comp_rules.shtml). As per the rules, Masters Rowers are those athletes who are over the age of 27 and are included in the following age categories:

- A Minimum age: 27 years
- B Average age: 36 years or more
- C Average age: 43 years or more
- D Average age: 50 years or more
- E Average age: 55 years or more
- F Average age: 60 years or more
- G Average age: 65 years or more
- H Average age: 70 years or more
- I Average age: 75 years or more
- J Average age: 80 years or more.

INDICATIVE PROGRAM

An indicative program of events will be released in a subsequent bulletin. Depending on participation levels racing is likely to start on the afternoon of Thursday, 3rd of June and conclude by mid afternoon on Sunday, 6th of June. Clubs should take into consideration the start time of the regatta when considering their logistical arrangements for trailer and athlete transportation.
